In other words it allows us to take some of the works out of our 'Private Collection' and give them some air and hopefully make a sale.

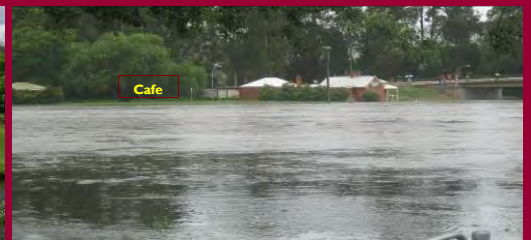
The QAS Calendar of Events for 2011 is on page six and it is great to have the full year already planned. Members can look forward to yet another exciting year.

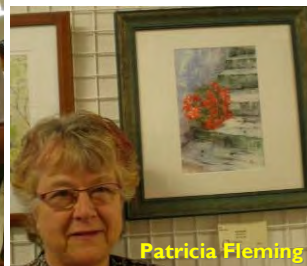

BIG BENEFIT FOR QUEANBEYAN

THE Rotary/Art Society Art Show held in City Walk Canberra has benefited **QUEANBEYAN** as follows:

- Queanbeyan** artists members' sales.
- Queanbeyan** charities \$5,000.
- Queanbeyan** Art Society calendar sales \$1,500.
- Queanbeyan** Art Society new members.
- Queanbeyan** West Rotary Club BBQ \$500.
- Queanbeyan** Art Society goodwill gained - half the sponsorship was from Canberra.

In **2008** Rotary/Art Society Competition Exhibition held in the QAS Gallery Queanbeyan with prizemoney. (has been tried).

In **2009** Rotary/Art Society Competition Exhibition held in front of the National Portrait Gallery Canberra with prizemoney. (two days washed out).

In **2010** Rotary/Art Society Art Show was held in City Walk Canberra without prizemoney. (huge success).

In **2011** there will be two thirds of the sponsors from Canberra and again a strong band of Queanbeyan sponsors. Already there is one new major sponsor for \$4,500. Please advise if you know of any potential sponsors.

RECORDING THE 2010 FLOOD HISTORY

SOME photos recording the Queanbeyan River flood on **Thursday 9th December 2010** at the QAS Gallery. The aerial view (below) of the Queanbeyan River in 'full flood' with the QAS Gallery on a island keeping its nose above water.



A consequence of this flood was the large number of dead trees floating mid stream. Water can be seen at the front door of the Gallery just at the top of the disabled ramp. The same photo (right) shows a cabin being lifted out of the caravan park by a huge crane.

The river reached 8.4 earlier in the day, surprising many and it was a rush to clear the caravans to the Queanbeyan Show Ground. In future there should be a flood plan and after what level the water reached this time is a good starting point.

THANKS FOR SUPPORT

THANKS to all the members, Friends of the Society and the Rotary Queanbeyan West Club for their offers of help after the flood. Many rang or emailed and quite a few turned up with their working gear on in anticipation to get into a big clean up. Thankfully only a small amount of water came in under the door with a little puddle the result. With sandbags at the front and back doors the Gallery could have taken another metre of water without works being threatened.



The historic photo shows the cottages just out of the **July 1922 Queanbeyan River flood**. The then **O'Neill Cottage** is highlighted and it appears the water level was about the same as on **9th Dec. 2010**.

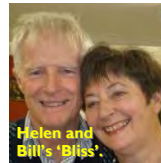

It would not take much to protect the Gallery by another metre in the first place by sand bagging or some extra soil in a area to keep the water back.

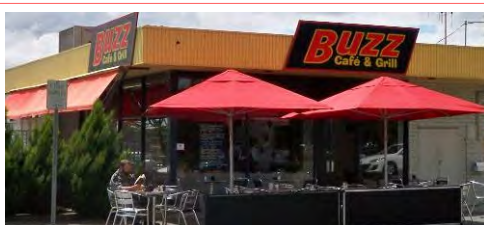
Many thanks to those who offered help after the flood - it shows the loyal supporters we have for our Society and they were not all members or artists.
