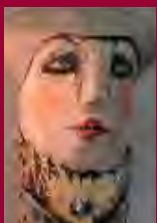

ENTRIES ALREADY IN FOR ROTARY ART SHOW

THE fourth Rotary/Art Society Art Show will be held over a week of Floriade from **Saturday 24th September to Sunday 2nd October 2011**.

The first was held at the QAS Gallery with great fanfare and the second in front of the National Portrait Gallery. Last year for the first time it was held in City Walk Canberra under mar-quees and it proved to be an outstanding success. Queanbeyan Mayor **Tim Over-all** will again officially open this year's Art Show in City Walk. Funds raised will go to the Rotary Queanbeyan West Club which they will distribute to regional



Charities and once again Rotary will set up its Mobile BBQ in City Walk to also help raise more funds for charity.

RQWC has a new president in **Will Blackwell** and he and wife Leone are keen art lovers which will hopefully boost the sales. Last year \$30,000 worth of art was sold at the Art Show.

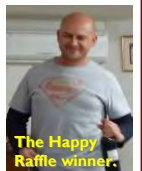
