COUNCIL EXHIBITION IS SOMETHING

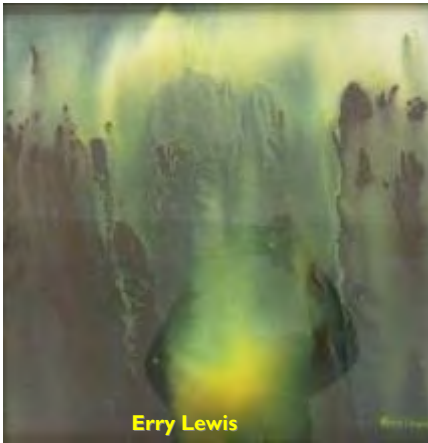
